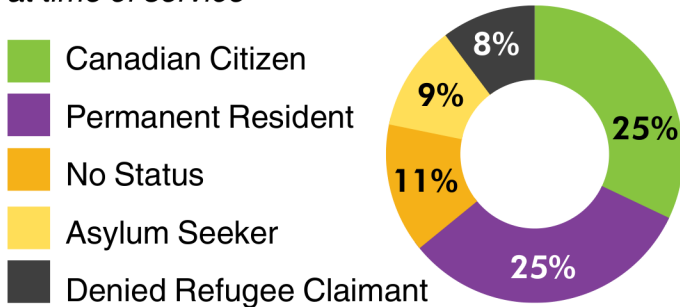

at time of service



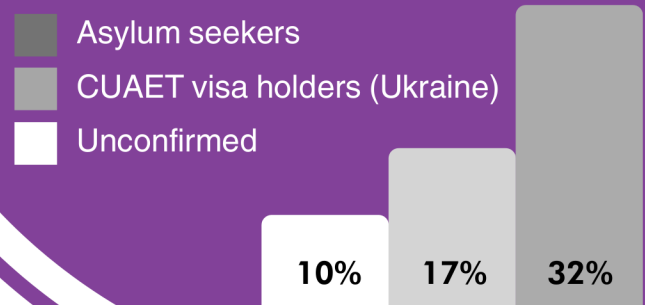
Unaccompanied and Separated Children
